

SECTION D – Children Horticultural

Children are aged up to 15 years and under, exhibiting will be judge according to their age group in the children's section.

All entries must be arranged by the exhibitor at the hall under the supervision of the stewards. Any exhibitor failing to do this or allowing any parent or friend to assist in arranging exhibits may be disqualified. (Please note that flowers must be in water or in a moist medium, e.g. oasis or wet sand).

Classes 3, 9, 10, 11, 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21 must have been grown by the exhibitor.

EXHIBITORS, PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE STAGED BETWEEN 7.30AM AND 9.30AM ON SATURDAY 19th OCTOBER.

CLASS 7 YEARS AND UNDER

1. Decorated saucer arranged in wet sand (max 180mm diameter)
2. Novelty exhibit – Favourite Character made from fruit/vegetables.
Must be named
3. Miniature Garden – (**must be growing**). Total area not to exceed 1.3 metres perimeter
4. Container of flowers decoratively arranged.
5. Arrangement using a pumpkin

CLASS 10 YEARS AND UNDER

6. Container of flowers decoratively arranged
7. Decorated saucer arranged in wet sand (max 180mm diameter)
8. Novelty exhibit – must contain fruit and/or vegetables and/or flowers.
(Must be named)
9. Plant growing in pot or container
10. Miniature garden (**must be growing**). Total area not to exceed 1.3 metres perimeter.
11. Terrarium
12. Arrangement using a pumpkin

CLASS 15 YEARS AND UNDER

13. Single flower arrangement
14. Novelty exhibit – Made from Fruit and/or Vegetables and/or Flowers.
15. Arrangement using a Pumpkin. (Must include flowers).
16. Floating Bowl. Water should be covered, and flowers contained inside bowl.
17. Terrarium
18. Plant growing in pot or container
19. Cactus or succulent, 1 pot
20. Miniature garden (**must be growing**). Total area not to exceed 1.3 metres perimeter.
21. Hanging basket or container
